

How to obtain your Manitoba cheque

If there is a postal service disruption, the Manitoba government has arranged for government cheques and other essential mail to be available for pick-up starting Thursday, May 26th. If you currently receive your payments or benefits by direct deposit, you will not be affected by the postal disruption.

Cheque pick-up information

All the offices are open **Monday to Friday between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.** unless otherwise indicated.

Please call **1-866-626-4862** or visit **www.manitoba.ca** before going to pick up your cheque and you will be provided with a number to call to ensure your cheque is ready.

Please bring proper identification with you when you pick up your cheque.

Manitoba Health cheques

Pharmacare, travel subsidy, out-of-province medical claims, insured benefits, doctor payments, etc. can be picked up at the main floor of 300 Carlton Street. (Cheques for those living outside of Winnipeg are available at the locations listed above.)

Maintenance Enforcement cheques

Cheques can be picked up at the Maintenance Enforcement Offices on the 2nd floor, 405 Broadway between 7:45 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday

C. Employment and Income Assistance Recipients in Winnipeg

If you deal with any of the Employment and Income offices located at Rorie Street, Market Street, or 896 Main Street, then pick up your cheque at The Aboriginal Health and Wellness Centre, 181 Higgins Avenue.

All other Employment and Income Assistance cheques can be picked up at your local community area office.
